3	An information pack has been created. The pack includes details of the hotline that has been set up to replace the Family Voice Hubs.  The Peterborough SEN and Inclusion Services have a daily hotline 10-11am, Monday-Friday for parents/carers, professionals and young people. No appointment is required and telephone calls are approximately 10 minutes long.

A range of educational support is made available through the Local Offer.

An example is a page containing newsletters produced by the <u>Autism/ADHD Advisory Teaching Service</u>. This page includes the childrens' newsletter 'Cosy Crew' and the parent carer newsletter 'I'm a parent get me out of here'. The page also links to the young people's newsletter, 'Lockdown Lift Off', which have been uploaded to the Local Offer for Young People.
